The Organization

ASHTAR is a Palestinian non-profit NGO founded in 1991 by two prominent, Palestinian actors, Edward Muallem and Iman Aoun. Today ASHTAR has a group of professional actors and directors, who use theatre beyond its artistic means to create social change in the Palestinian civil society. The theatre offers theatre training programs for both locals and internationals, where participants get the chance to improve their drama skills as well as engage in cultural exchange. One of ASHTAR's specialties is Forum Theatre – a genre, that aims to transform a commonly passive audience into active and involved participants. With Forum Theatre, ASHTAR seeks to promote a more active dialogue and commitment to change with the society. The mission of ASHTAR is to contribute to the creation of a free, equal, and just society by utilising theatre as a tool to encourage marginalised groups, such as youth and women, to become imaginative, progressive, and productive agents of social change who are able to express themselves and communicate with their surroundings creatively.
